## Vaccine Bubble for Campus Access

Starting from 24 February 2022, all students and staff entering HKBU Campuses (including SCE Learning Centres) must follow the vaccine bubble arrangements, with details as follows:

- 1. *From 24 February 2022 to 4 May 2022*, the following persons are allowed to enter the campuses upon fulfilment of all the specified conditions stipulated on the health declaration.
  - a) Persons who are fully vaccinated (i.e. have completed the vaccination course for 14 days) <sup>[note 1]</sup>; OR
  - Persons who have received at least ONE dose of vaccine against COVID-19, and submit a negative result of COVID-19 test [note 2] that is carried out within 7 days from the day of access; OR
  - c) Persons who have obtained approval from the University to be exempted from vaccination due to medical reasons, and submit a negative result of COVID-19 test <sup>[note 2]</sup> that is carried out within **3 days** from the day of access. Application for exemption should be made at least 10 working days prior to the day of access.

- 2. *From 5 May 2022 onwards*, the following persons are allowed to enter the campuses upon fulfilment of all the specified conditions stipulated on the health declaration.
  - a) Persons who are fully vaccinated (i.e. have completed the vaccination course for 14 days) [note 1]; OR
  - b) Persons who have obtained approval from the University to be exempted from vaccination due to medical reasons, and submit a negative result of COVID-19 test <sup>[note 2]</sup> that is carried out within **3 days** from the day of access. Application for exemption should be made at least 10 working days prior to the day of access.
