香港浸會大學 HONG KONG BAPTIST UNIVERSITY

Hong Kong Baptist College was founded by the Baptist Convention of Hong Kong in 1956 as a post-secondary college committed to the provision of a whole person education. In 1983, it became a fully-funded public tertiary institution, and the College gained university status just over a decade later. It was renamed Hong Kong Baptist University (HKBU) in 1994.

Over the years, HKBU has remained committed to the pursuit of excellence in education, research and service to the community. As one of Asia's finest institutions of higher learning, HKBU is dedicated to nurturing future generations of civically engaged community members, and it provides them with a broad-based, transdisciplinary and creative education.

Its eight faculties/schools offer a wide array of programmes across a diverse range of disciplines, from the arts, business, communication, and social sciences to science and technology, Chinese medicine and sport.

With its fundamental strengths in the arts and humanities, HKBU offers an education and research environment that fosters technological progress with a focus on the human dimensions. At the same time, the University is using technology to push the envelope of human imagination in the arts and cultural sphere. Coupled with our unceasing efforts to achieve breakthroughs in science and Chinese medicine, HKBU strives to contribute to the building of a better world and a more compassionate society.

香港浸會學院是由香港浸信會聯會於1956年創辦的私立高等學府,致力提供全人教育。1983年,當時的香港浸會學院獲政府全面資助,成為公立專上學府,至1994年獲得正名,成為香港浸會大學(浸大)。多年來,浸大一直在教育、研究及社會服務上追求卓越。作為亞洲最優秀的高等教育學府之一,浸大致力培育未來世代成為貢獻社會的英才,為他們提供廣泛多元、跨學科及具創意的教育。浸大設有八個學院,為學生提供多樣化的學科選擇,由藝術、工商管理、傳理、社會科學以至科技、中醫及體育等等。

浸大在藝術及人文領域堅實的基礎上,提供適切的教學及研究 環境,推動以人為本的科技發展,同時利用科技不斷開拓人類在 藝術和文化的想像空間,並在科學及中醫領域上不斷帶來突破, 銳意建立一個更美好的世界及仁愛的社會。



Established in 2000, the College of International Education (CIE) is a self-funded unit of HKBU, offering full-time Associate Degree Programme (AD) and Undergraduate Programmes (UG). The CIE, managed by the School of Continuing Education (SCE), currently enrols around 3,500 students and is committed to the University's mission of providing quality whole person higher education with a Christian heritage. Students can enjoy the quality campus facilities and amenities in the Shek Mun (Shatin) campus, along with the additional resources available at the HKBU Kowloon Tong and KaiTak campuses.

Ample Articulation Opportunities and High Articulation Rate 多元升學途徑 超過九成畢業生成功升讀學士學位

- In 2023, the articulation rate reached 90.7%. Among these graduates, 81.2% were admitted to undergraduate programmes offered by the eight UGC-funded local universities.
- The College places great emphasis on providing different articulation opportunities for students. Students can take the "2+2" study mode and earn a Bachelor's Degree in 4 years.
- CIE offers 27 AD Concentration Studies across the 5 major disciplines of Applied Science, Arts and Languages, Business, Communication, and Social Sciences. The wide range of choices in our curriculum and flexibility in choosing elective courses cater to different interests, talents and aspirations of our students.
- CIE also offers 11 undergraduate programmes to allow AD graduates to earn an HKBU Honours Degree through seamless articulation.
- 2023學年副學士畢業生升學率高達90.7%,當中81.2%升讀八間 教資會資助院校學士學位課程。
- 國際學院為同學提供多元升學出路,讓同學可以「2+2」 升學模式,四年完成學士學位。
- 課程選擇廣泛,27項副學士專修涵蓋五大學術範疇,包括應用 科學、人文及語言學、商學、傳理學與社會科學。同學可按學習 興趣、才能和志向,靈活組合選修科目。
- 學院更開辦11個自資學士學位課程,畢業生可無縫銜接,最終 獲浸大頒授榮譽學士學位。

Four-year Through-train Admissions Scheme

四年自資學位課程直通車入學計畫

The Scheme provides eligible applicants with a direct and hassle-free articulation opportunity. Applicants who have fulfilled the admission requirements (HKDSE score of "33222" or "3322A", or other admission requirements) may be given offers to both HKBU Associate Degree (AD) and Self-funded Undergraduate Programmes (UG) upon admission, and awarded an HKBU Honours Degree in 4 years. During their AD studies, students will be given a chance to change their selected UG Programme according to their interests and talents.

計畫為合資格的申請人提供一個明確、簡單方便的直接升學機會。只要符合入學要求(香港中學文憑試成績達「33222」或「3322A」或其他入學要求),申請人於申請副學士課程時,即有機會同時獲得浸大副學士及自資學士學位課程的錄取資格,從而可用四年時間取得由浸大頒授的榮譽學士學位。同學就讀副學士期間更可按學習興趣及才能,修改自資學士學位課程選擇,升學途徑更靈活。



Earn a Bachelor's Degree awarded by the Eight UGC-funded Universities 升讀八大政府資助學士學位

In the 2024/25 academic year, there are a total of 5,000 senior year places (Year 3) at different full-time UGC-funded Undergraduate Programmes across the eight UGC-funded local universities. AD graduates can articulate to the senior year places through the Non-JUPAS scheme and will be able to obtain a bachelor's degree granted by the eight UGC-funded local universities in 4 years, equivalent to the study period required by the JUPAS route to UGC-funded Programmes after DSE.







This programme, which also emphasises quality management in the food service industry, equips graduates to pursue further studies and career opportunities in the fields of nutrition and food management. Typically, graduates proceed to articulate into Bachelor's Degree Programmes that are related to subjects such as nutritional science, food safety and testing, health science, or applied science.

SOCIOLOGY AND **DIGITAL SOCIETY**

Digital technologies impact our society, culture and the self. They shape all aspects of our everyday lives and become interconnected with social relations, labour markets, education, health, security, recreation and other areas of the social world. We have seen changes in the way public services, consumption, and transportation delivered through digital mechanisms such as apps and digital platforms. This brings positives but many challenges remain such as the rise of fake news, cybercrime, misinformation and inequalities generated by digital technologies. This area of Concentration Studies aims to introduce students to a variety of topics informed by sociological theory and methodology and help them to make sense of the digital society to make a better future.

Distinctive features include:

- Equipping students with broad-based training in sociology;
- Providing students with theoretical training and the essential skills in social research, to critically understand and analyse the digital society.





Students who can apply sociology to explain human behaviour in the digital society have diverse career prospects. They can find opportunities in the government, social media management, digital marketing, journalism, social research, and education. Their ability to critically analyse the social implications of digital platforms on social structures, and cultural practices allows them to address the complex challenges that arise in the digital era.



The majority of graduates from our Concentration Studies successfully obtained senior places in both UGC-funded and self-funded sports-related undergraduate programmes in local universities, with an articulation rate of around 80%.

CIE believes that students need to embrace diversity of cultures and practices, knowledge and skills to meet the changing needs of the world. In order to foster an appreciation and understanding of cultural diversity, the College provides a range of cultural exchange and overseas experiential learning activities to our students. In past years, CIE students participated in different exchange programmes, including HKBU University Exchange Tours, Global Attachment Opportunities, Metropolitan Attachment Programmes, as well as various overseas study tours organised by CIE.

Although COVID-19 made international travel difficult, CIE has turned this challenge into an opportunity. Appreciation and respect for other cultures are fostered through classroom learning, extra-curricular activities and experiential learning activities. Students from international partner universities, scholars, writers, business leaders and industry experts from abroad are invited to give talks and seminars online to cultivate multicultural sensitivity and competence, as well as to improve our students' knowledge of global affairs.

Virtual Exchange Centre (VEC) is established to coordinate and provide support to extra-curricular, co-curricular and curriculum virtual exchange opportunities with overseas higher education institutions. It is wished that students' global perspective and intercultural competency can be enhanced after engaging in these exchanges.

 - 1. "Attained" is deemed to have achieved "Level 2":
 - 2."Attained with Distinction (I)" is deemed to have achieved "Level 3"; and
 - 3."Attained with Distinction (II)" is deemed to have achieved "Level 4".
- ^ If one of the HKDSE subjects is "Citizenship and Social Development" (CSD), the minimum entrance requirement would become "Attained" for CSD and Level 2 in four other HKDSE subjects, including Chinese and English. Besides, Level 2 in Mathematics Extended Part (Module 1 or Module 2) is also recognised as one of the five HKDSE subjects in fulfilling the minimum entrance requirement.
- For Non-Chinese Speaking (NCS) HKDSE candidates, the following alternative Chinese Language qualifications are recognised by the College of International Education as equivalent to HKDSE Chinese Language:
 - 1. Grade E or above in GCE A/AS Level Chinese; or
 - 2. Grade C or above in GCSE/IGCSE/GCE O-Level Chinese; or
