6	Outbound Exchange Grant	An outbound exchange grant for one full-time student of BEd(Hons) joining an exchange tour offered by the SCE.	HK\$10,000 or the cost of the tour whichever is lower	Open application
7	Scheme for Subsidy on Exchange for Post- secondary Students (SSE)	Introduced by Education Bureau (EDB) to ensure that no post-secondary students will be denied access to exchange activities due to a lack of financial means.  For full-time BEd(Hons) students receiving means-tested student financial assistance or Comprehensive Social Security Assistance who join an exchange tour.	Depends on the destination and duration of the tour	Open application
8	Scheme for Subsidy on Exchange to "Belt and Road" Regions for Post- secondary Students (SSEBR)	Introduced by EDB to capitalise on the new opportunities created by the "one belt one road" initiatives as well as strengthen and promote further educational exchanges between Hong Kong and the countries along the Belt and Road (B&R).  For full-time BEd(Hons) students receiving means-tested student financial assistance or Comprehensive Social Security Assistance who join an exchange tour to Belt and Road countries.	Depends on the destination and duration of the tour	Open application
